STEP 2 ---Claim Your Account



Within 48 hours of submitting your application, you should receive an automated e-mail when your myUCCS student portal account is ready. You can then proceed to <https://accounts.uccs.edu> to claim your account to access your student portal ---where you can register, pay your bill, etc.

- **Keep this username and password for future access into your myUCCS Student Portal and to order a Transcript**
- Please note: automated e-mails may go to "junk mail," depending upon your e-mail filter.
- If you have been accepted to UCCS for future degree seeking, you already have a student portal and will not receive the automated email. Log in with your existing credentials or proceed to 'claim your account'.

STEP 3 ---Register

Log In to your myUCCS student portal at www.uccs.edu/portal

Registration --- Click on **"Records and Registration"** (near the top of the screen) and from the next screen, click on **"Register for Classes"**

- ✓ Pre-registration verifications: address('Home' address marked as 'Local'), phone numbers, emergency contact
- ✓ Tuition and Fee Agreement and Disclosure

- **Search by Class Number.** Enter 5-digit Class Number listed above. Click **"Submit Class Number"**
- Confirm the details of the course and click **"Next"**
- **Check the box** of the course you would like to enroll, under the **"Select"** column
- Click **"Add Selected Classes"**
- Confirm the course and click **"Finish Enrolling"**

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What is CU Succeed?

CU Succeed is a unique partnership between the University of Colorado Colorado Springs (UCCS) and Colorado high schools. The program provides current high school students with the opportunity to earn college academic credit while concurrently satisfying high school requirements, saving time and money in completing a college degree. Registration through UCCS for academic credit is OPTIONAL.

CU Succeed courses appear on an official UCCS transcript, as do other courses of the University. Policies regarding the transfer of credits and the specific ways in which they apply to degree requirements vary from institution to institution. You should always seek advising from the appropriate advisor at the college or university you plan to attend to ensure you are selecting the appropriate coursework for your degree and to ensure it will apply to those degree requirements.



Grading Policies for the CU Succeed *****IMPORTANT, read carefully*****

Grades earned in CU Succeed courses become a part of a student's University of Colorado academic record and official transcript. Therefore, it is extremely important that a student earn at least a 'C' grade in PLTW courses. A grade of 'C-minus' or below could prevent a student from being admitted to any campus in the University of Colorado system, regardless of the student's high school GPA or college entrance exam scores. A 'C-minus' corresponds to a GPA of 1.70, and students must have a minimum of a 2.0 University GPA to be admitted to or remain in good standing at UCCS. To withdraw from a course, email pltw@uccs.edu *prior* to the completion of the course.

The student's college transcript grade will be weighed in a 50/50 formula. 50% = PLTW End of Course Assessment, 50% = PLTW classroom assignments, exams, other coursework = 50%

To receive assistance from the UCCS Helpdesk, UCCS community members (including high school dual credit students) will be required to join a Zoom call with the Service Desk during normal business hours and present a government-issued ID or high school student ID alongside their face as they would be required to do if visiting the Helpdesk in person. As attackers have been able to acquire more and more personal identifying information, which is typically used for identity verification, this is the only way the UCCS Helpdesk can confidently protect UCCS accounts. Due to FERPA, Helpdesk staff will only work on accounts when the student is on the phone or chat.
